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Center Ridge Road Widening Project Update 1-5-2017

The project includes the widening of Center Ridge Road from Stoney Ridge Road to Lear Nagle Road. It also includes the realignment of the Root Road and Ridgeview Boulevard intersection, new traffic signals, a 10-foot wide multi-use path on the south side, storm sewers, and four detention basins. Side streets will be improved adjacent to Center Ridge Road, and a new street named Sinta Run will be constructed from Jaycox Road to the North Ridge Plaza (Marc's shopping center). The bridges over Robinson Ditch on Center Ridge Road and Root Road will be replaced.

Property acquisition by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) is complete. A few parcels to be acquired using eminent domain are still in court, but access for the new permanent right of way has been obtained. The building demolition contract administered by ODOT and performed by All Aspects Contracting has been completed.

The new sanitary sewer installation on the south side of Center Ridge Road administered by the City of North Ridgeville has been completed by DiGioia Suburban Excavating LLC.

Utility relocation is well underway. Ohio Edison has completed their work from the east end of the project up to approximately Jaycox Road. Columbia Gas has completed most of their work from the east end of the project up to Avon Belden Road. Columbia Gas expects to complete the rest of the main line work and the gas service lines sometime this Spring. All utility relocation is expected to be complete by early summer of 2017.

ODOT is expected to advertise the roadway construction project in the fall of 2017 and construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2018. Two-way traffic will be maintained during construction.
