### **ORDINANCES**

(The following Ordinances were passed by City Council on April 7, 2014)

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE RELOCATION OF MULTIPLE CELL TOWER COMMUNICATION APPARATUS NECESSARY TO SERVE THE CITY'S SAFETY AND SERVICE FORCES NOT TO EXCEED \$70,000.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the existing cellular/wireless communications tower located on City property at the Service Garage facility is antiquated and will soon be decommissioned; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has negotiated an agreement pursuant to which cell tower communication apparatus necessary to serve requisite needs of the City's Police, Fire and Service Departments shall be collocated on a tower which shall be constructed on real property adjacent to City Hall and owned by the North Ridgeville Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, the project will involve the consolidation of contracts and/or materials from multiple vendors, none of which shall involve the expenditure of funds in excess of the statutory limit requiring public advertising and bidding; and

WHEREAS, this expense was approved by Council and has been appropriated.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into contracts and commit the City to expend funds necessary to complete the cell tower apparatus location project, including required appurtenances, not to exceed \$70,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** The expense of this project shall be charged to and paid from the appropriate fund.

**SECTION 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to meet the timing deadlines and for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

# 5120-2014 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING N.R.C.O. SECTION 242.09, AMBULANCE AND PARAMEDIC FEES, BY UPDATING RESIDENT AND NON-RESIDENT BILLING RATES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Ridgeville is currently charging fees for ambulance and paramedic services which are inadequate to cover the cost of the service provided, and has not increased fees in approximately seven years; and

**WHEREAS,** N.R.C.O. Section 242.09(a), *Ambulance and Paramedic Fees*, currently provides as follows:

<u>Service</u>	<b>Resident Fee</b>	<b>Nonresident Fee</b>
BLS, emergency transport	\$375.00	\$375.00
ALS, emergency transport, specialized ALS services rendered	475.00	475.00
Mileage charge (per mile) for both ALS and BLS runs	7.00	7.00

Note: Suppliers and fuels are included in the above rates.

### NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** N.R.C.O. Section 242.09(a), *Ambulance and Paramedic Fees*, is hereby amended as follows:

<u>Service</u>	<b>Resident Fee</b>	<b>Nonresident Fee</b>
BLS, emergency transport	\$450.00	\$450.00
ALS, emergency transport, specialized ALS services rendered	\$750.00	\$750.00
Mileage charge (per mile) for both ALS and BLS runs	\$12.00	\$12.00

Note: Suppliers and fuels are included in the above rates.

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being for the prompt, prudent and appropriate revenue streams. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

#### RESOLUTIONS

(The following Resolutions were passed by City Council on April 7, 2014)

1302-2014 A RESOLUTION URGING OHIO VOTERS TO SUPPORT STATE ISSUE 1-RENEWAL OF THE STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM ON THE MAY 6, 2014 BALLOT.

WHEREAS, Ohio local communities are in continuing need of support for vital road, bridge, sewer, water and other infrastructure projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio has in place a state program of support for local communities which not only helps to fund infrastructure projects, but also creates large numbers of construction and allied jobs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio State Capital Improvements Program has successfully provided support for more than 11,500 such projects and resulting job creation since its inception in 1987; and

**WHEREAS,** Issue 1 on the May 6, 2014 statewide ballot provides Ohio voters with the opportunity to renew the program by authorizing issuance of \$1.875 billion in capital improvement bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, no new taxes are required to fund repayment of the bonds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The City of North Ridgeville hereby declares its support for State Issue 1 and urges Ohio voters to cast their votes in support of continuing the infrastructure improvement and job creation Issue 1 will foster.

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
