RESOLUTION(S)

1436-2018 A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A RENEWAL TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE LORAIN PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM, INCLUDING THE OPERATION OF A BRANCH LIBRARY LOCATED IN THE CITY.

(R.C. Sections 5705.03, 5705.19(D), 5705.25)
Renewal Public Library Operating Levy

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio (the "City") is currently levying a one and ninety-one hundredths (1.91) mill, five-year levy for the purpose of providing for current operating expenses for the Lorain Public Library System, Lorain County, Ohio (the "Library"), approved by the voters of the City on May 6, 2014, and first placed on the tax list and duplicate in 2014 for collection commencing in 2015, and final collection in 2019 (the "Existing Levy");

WHEREAS, the Board of Library Trustees of the Library wishes the City Council of the City to initiate proceedings for the submission to the electors in the entire territory of the City the question of a renewal of the existing levy for current expenses of the Lorain Public Library System, including the operation of a branch library located in the City;

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Library; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution declaring the necessity of levying an additional tax outside the ten-mill limitation must be passed and certified to the County Auditor of Lorain County in order to permit the City to consider the levy of such a renewal tax and must request that the County Auditor certify to the City the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal tax levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. It is necessary to renew all of the existing levy for the purpose of providing for current operating expenses of Lorain Public Library System, including the operation of a branch library operated in the City.

Section 2. The Lorain County Auditor is hereby requested to certify the current assessed valuation of the City and the dollar amount to be generated by renewal of a one and ninety-one hundredths (1.91) mill levy for the benefit of the Library, for the purpose of providing current operating revenues for the Library, including the operation of a branch library located in the City, upon the entire territory of the City.

Section 3. The question of such renewal tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the City at the election to be held therein on May 7, 2019 and such renewal levy shall be placed upon the tax list and duplicate for the 2019 tax year, beginning in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020, for five years if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof. All the territory of the city is in Lorain County.

Section 4. The Auditor of the City is hereby authorized and directed to deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to the Lorain County Auditor.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

1437-2018 A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS TO ZASHIN & RICH CO., L.P.A. FOR LEGAL SERVICES RENDERED IN CONNECTION WITH THE FLSA OVERTIME ISSUE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, O.R.C. §5705.41 provides that City Council may authorize the payment of amounts due, wherein legislation shall be passed within thirty (30) days from receipt of a certificate of the fiscal officer in accordance with O.R.C. §5705.41(D)(1); and

WHEREAS, the fiscal officer does certify that the expenditure was and is properly appropriated and otherwise lawful, sufficient funds were and are available or in the process of collection to the credit of the proper fund, and the funds were and are free from any previous encumbrance; and

WHEREAS, Zashin & Rich Co., L.P.A. is providing legal services to the City in connection with FLSA overtime issue, and serves a necessary public purpose; and

WHEREAS, legal services rendered from May through September of this year by Zashin & Rich Co., L.P.A. has exceeded the fiscal officer's certification of available funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes payment in the amount of \$14,322.48 to Zashin & Rich Co. L.P.A for legal services provided to the City in connection with the FLSA overtime issue, which has exceeded the fiscal officer’s certification.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate need to pay the invoice timely since services have already been rendered and invoiced. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
