## ORDINANCE(S)

**5320-2016 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPROPRIATIONS OF MONEY FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2016 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to pass an appropriation ordinance providing for the current expenses and other expenditures for the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That to provide for current and other expenditures for the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio for the period commencing January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 the following sums are hereby set aside and appropriated.

**SECTION 3.** That the Auditor of the City of North Ridgeville is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Treasury of the City of North Ridgeville for payments on any of the foregoing appropriations, upon receiving proper certification and vouchers therefore, approved by officers authorized by law to approve the same or by an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditure and provide that no warrants may be drawn or paid for salaries or wages, except to persons employed by authority of or in accordance with law or Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to meet the county auditor deadline of March 31, 2016. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

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**5321-2016      AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT ACCORDING TO LAW AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY LAW WITH BOJHUN ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, A PROFESSIONAL LAB TESTING FIRM, NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS,** the recent retirement of the lab technician at the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant has left the plant unable to perform lab testing; and

**WHEREAS,** Bojhun Environmental Services is a professional environmental firm assisting the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant with regulatory compliance, storm water mitigation, satellite sewer system management, laboratory support and pre-treatment sampling.

**WHEREAS,** Bojhun Environmental Services will provide water sampling and testing, support and oversight to the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant in order to comply with the treatment plant's NPDES permit requirements. It also will provide training to the new lab technician, once hired.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into a contract according to law and in a manner prescribed by law with Bojhun Environmental Services, a professional environmental firm, not to exceed \$90,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** The costs associated with this company shall be paid from and charged to the appropriate fund.

**SECTION 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to fund the contract. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

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**5322-2016      AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR A TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD, ACCORDING TO LAW AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF CHEMICALS TO BE USED BY THE FRENCH CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT.**

**WHEREAS,** the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant is in need of the below listed chemicals which are used for treating wastewater.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to advertise for bids according to law, and in a manner prescribed by law, for the purchase of the below listed chemicals which are used for treating wastewater:

Polymer	Sodium Hypochlorite	Magnesium Bisulfate
Ferrous Chloride	Sodium Bisulfate	

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the above chemicals with the lowest and best bidder.

**SECTION 3.** The cost of said chemicals shall be charged to and paid from the appropriate City funds in accordance with use consumption.

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to negotiate a contract for the above materials with the lowest and best bidder.

**SECTION 3.** The cost of said asphalt and related materials shall be charged to and paid from the appropriate City funds in accordance with use consumption.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**WHEREAS,** the rental of equipment and services for road repair and maintenance is needed for the City of North Ridgeville Service Department's street paving program which is scheduled to begin in April 2016 and end in November 2016.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 2.** The rental costs are not to exceed the amount appropriated, and shall be charged to and paid from the appropriate City funds.

**WHEREAS,** Section 5513.01(B) of the Ohio Revised Code provides the opportunity for Counties, Townships, Municipal Corporations, Port Authorities, Regional Transit Authorities, State Colleges/Universities and County Transit Boards to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies, or other articles, including sodium chloride.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into participation agreements through the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of sodium chloride (road salt) for the 2016 summer and 2016/2017 winter seasons.

**SECTION 2.** The cost of said road salt shall be charged to and paid from the appropriate City funds.

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**5329-2016 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3727-2001 BY CORRECTING THE JOB TITLE OF PARKS AND RECREATION PROGRAM “DIRECTOR” TO PARKS AND RECREATION PROGRAM “SUPERVISOR”.**

**WHEREAS,** Ordinance No. 3727-2001 incorrectly referred to the Parks and Recreation Program “Supervisor” as the Parks and Recreation Program “Director” and therefore requires correction.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** Ordinance No. 3727-2001 is hereby amended by correcting Parks and Recreation Program “Director” to Parks and Recreation Program “Supervisor” at all points where the position is referenced within Ordinance No. 3727-2001.

**SECTION 2.** All other provisions of Ordinance No. 3727-2001 not specifically modified or affected by this amending Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall be deemed to clarify and establish the position title to be “Parks and Recreation Program Supervisor” and thus shall serve to supersede and correct any contrary reference to that position in prior legislation or administrative records.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
