ORDINANCE NO. 5572-2018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF VEHICLES/EQUIPMENT NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville has a number of vehicles/equipment which are obsolete, and/or not needed, and/or unfit for public use; and

WHEREAS, the sale of such property is one of the powers of local self-government, conferred by Section 3, Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution when exercised in conjunction with the general law; and

WHEREAS, O.R.C. §721.15(A) provides that such sale be authorized by the passage of an authorizing ordinance when the estimated value of the property is more than \$1,000.00, that the vehicle goes to the highest and best bidder, and that the sale be advertised as required under the statute; and

WHEREAS, the North Ridgeville City Council finds that the value of each vehicle is more than \$1,000.00; and further finds that due to the amount of vehicles/equipment, the sale will better be accomplished through the services of the Greater Cleveland Auto Auction, and that such sale is also required to comply with O.R.C. §721.15(A).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council finds the following vehicles/equipment no longer serve a municipal purpose and hereby approves the sale of the obsolete/unneeded/unfit vehicles/ equipment in the manner authorized by law and the proceeds be deposited into the appropriate account:
