ORDINANCE NO. 5786-2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 5785-2020 OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, PROVIDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2020 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the appropriations for certain funds and appropriate other amounts for the operations of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio.

WHEREAS, a redistribution of CARES Act funding was received in the Treasury on December 1, 2020 from Lorain County Auditors. These funds are required to be available for encumbrance by December 31, 2020.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these funds retroactively to December 1, 2020 to ensure compliance with the Ohio Office of Budget and Management’s most current guidance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That to provide for current and other expenditures for the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, for the period commencing January 1, 2020, and ending December 31, 2020, Ordinance No. 5690-2019 and as amended in Ordinance 5785-2020 and the same are hereby supplemented in the following amounts retroactive to December 1, 2020, the appropriation Ordinance shall include the following, being adjusted for the similar terms in the preceding appropriation Ordinance.

SECTION 2. That there be appropriated from the respective funds listed below, the amounts as follows:

SECTION 3. That the Auditor of the City of North Ridgeville is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Treasury of the City of North Ridgeville for payments on any of the foregoing appropriations, upon receiving proper certification and vouchers therefore, approved by officers authorized by law to approve the same or by an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditure and provide that no warrants may be drawn or paid for salaries or wages, except to persons employed by authority of or in accordance with law or Ordinance.


SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being due to the Ordinance being retroactive to December 1, 2020. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 5787-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, ACCORDING TO LAW AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY LAW, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE MILLS ROAD BRIDGE OVER FRENCH CREEK (LOR-MILLS ROAD) REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND OTHER APPURTANENCES, NOT TO EXCEED \$1,047,512.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the bridge on Mills Road over French Creek was built in 1928 and recent inspections and analyses have indicated that the deck slab is in serious condition, the foundations are not designed to carry current highway loads, and the waterway opening is undersized; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for a grant through the Ohio Department's Municipal Bridge Program for replacement of the existing deficient, single span, concrete slab bridge with a single span, precast, reinforced concrete, three-sided culvert with cast-in-place wing-walls and footings on drilled shafts; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of construction, including inspection, is \$1,206,712.00. The City of North Ridgeville has received a grant of federal funds in the amount of \$776,000.00 from the Ohio Department of Transportation, therefore leaving the local share for which the City will be responsible to be estimated at \$430,712.00; and

WHEREAS, plans and bidding documents will be available in the City of North Ridgeville Engineering Department for the Mills Road Bridge over French Creek (LOR-MILLS ROAD) Replacement Project and other appurtenances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract according to law and in a manner prescribed by law with the lowest and best bidder for the Mills Road Bridge over French Creek (LOR-MILLS ROAD) Replacement Project and other appurtenances, in an amount not to exceed \$1,047,512.00.

SECTION 2. The cost of the Mills Road Bridge Replacement Project shall be charged to and paid from the appropriate City funds.



It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being due to ODOT's deadline on March 2, 2021. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
