**RESOLUTION NO. 1534-2021**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATES BY THE FISCAL OFFICER AND THE PAYMENT OF AMOUNTS DUE FOR VARIOUS PURCHASE ORDERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(D)(1), the City may not enter into any contract or give any order involving the expenditure of money unless there is attached thereto a certificate of the City's Fiscal Officer that the amount required to meet the obligation has been lawfully appropriated for such purpose and is in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(D)(1) further provides that in such circumstances when no certificate is furnished as required and the expenditure is for \$3,000.00 or more, the City's Council, as the City's taxing authority, may authorize the drawing of a warrant in payment of amounts due upon such contract or order upon certification by the City's Fiscal Officer that there was at the time of the execution of such certificate a sufficient sum appropriated for such purpose in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Fiscal Officer certifies that the expenditure was and is properly appropriated and otherwise lawful; sufficient funds were and are available or in the process of collection to the credit of the proper fund, and the funds were and are free from any previous encumbrance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is issuing Then and Now Certificates in connection with payments due and owing as shown in Exhibit A attached; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council deems it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the City to approve the execution by the City Fiscal Officer of Then and Now Certificates, and to authorize the payment of amounts due under the contracts or orders requiring the expenditure of \$3,000.00 or more.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** City Council, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(D)(1), hereby approves the execution of the Then and Now Certificates by the Fiscal Officer and authorized payment due and owing as shown in Exhibit A attached and incorporated herein.



**ORDINANCE NO. 5868-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE TO PURCHASE FIVE NEW POLICE VEHICLES AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FROM THE STATE BID LIST OR CO-OP, OR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH AN OUTSIDE VENDOR, ACCORDING TO LAW AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY LAW, NOT TO EXCEED \$270,000.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, City Council has approved and appropriated funds for five replacement vehicles for the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the purchases will also involve contracts for equipment and materials from multiple vendors, all of which shall be selected from the State of Ohio bid lists or cooperatives of approved and previously bid assets and services, or from vendors offering identical items and/or services at prices less than those appearing on State “bid lists”; and

**WHEREAS**, with the exception of the vehicles, none of the individual vendor contracts for purchase shall involve the expenditure of funds in excess of the statutory limit requiring public advertising or bidding.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of five new vehicles and necessary equipment for the Police Department from the State Bid List or Co-Op, or from vendors offering prices below that of the State pre-bid forums, or to advertise for bids, according to law and in a manner prescribed by law, and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder in the cumulative amount, not to exceed \$270,000.00

**SECTION 2.** The cost of the police vehicles and equipment shall be charged to and paid from the appropriate City fund.


**SECTION 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being in order to accelerate the purchase of five police vehicles to save money. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

**ORDINANCE NO. 5869-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, ACCORDING TO LAW AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY LAW, WITH A CONSULTING ENGINEERING FIRM FOR IMPROVEMENT PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE SUGAR RIDGE ROAD SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION, NOT TO EXCEED \$92,000.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Ridgeville desires to extend sanitary sewers along Sugar Ridge Road from 36696 Sugar Ridge Road east to SR 83 for approximately 2,850 feet; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Ridgeville has appropriated the necessary funds for the engineering and design of construction plans and specifications for the Sugar Ridge Sanitary Sewer Extension Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Ridgeville has received a proposal from a consulting engineering firm to provide design services, construction plans, and specification preparation for the Sugar Ridge Road Sanitary Sewer Extension; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor of the City of North Ridgeville is hereby authorized to enter into a contract, according to law and in a manner prescribed by law, with a consulting engineering firm for engineering design services, construction plans, and specification preparation for the Sugar Ridge Road Sanitary Sewer Extension in an amount not to exceed \$92,000.00.


