

The Lorain County Commissioners are pleased to announce the reopening of the Collection Center and tire sites with restrictions due to COVID-19.



The Lorain County Collection Center located at 540 S. Abbe Rd., Elyria will begin limited operations on the following Saturdays: July 11, July 18, July 25, and August 1, 2020. Hours of collection are from 9am to 3pm.

The Lorain Tire Site, located at 114 E 35<sup>th</sup> Street, Lorain will be open on the following Tuesdays: July 7, July 14, July 21, and July 28, 2020 from 9am to 1pm.

The Grafton Tire Site located at 17109 Avon Belden Rd, Grafton will be open on the following Saturdays: July 11, July 18, July 25, and August 1, 2020 from 9am to 1pm. Hours are subject to change for all sites; please check the website for the most up-to-date hours.



When packing your vehicle, all materials to be dropped off should be in the rear compartment or truck bed of the vehicle (no materials in the front or rear seat) and do not place other personal items by items to be dropped off. Once at the Collection Center or tire sites, participants must remain in their vehicles at all times. Staff at the Collection Center or tire sites will request to visually see your ID to prove Lorain County residency and will request name and contact information. Wait times may be longer than usual, so please plan accordingly. Future operating schedules will be evaluated after August 1.
