1330-2015 A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE THE QUESTION OF THE RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING TAX FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS AND BRIDGES IN THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.19(G) AND 5705.191 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2014, this Council adopted Resolution No. 1322-2014 pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code declaring it necessary to renew an existing 1.9-mill tax levy for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, and requesting the Lorain County Auditor to certify the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that renewal levy; and

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2015, the Lorain County Auditor certified that the total current tax valuation of the City is \$715,395,780 and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that 1.9-mill renewal levy would be \$1,340,443 annually during the life of the levy, assuming that the total current tax valuation remains the same throughout the life of the levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, not less than two-thirds of all members of said Council elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1. This Council finds, determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised by the City of North Ridgeville within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax list and duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of this City, and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation at the rate of 1.9 mills for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the City of North

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Ridgeville, Ohio, being a purpose set forth in Section 5705.19(G) of the Ohio Revised Code, for a period of five years.

Section 2. The question of renewing the City's existing 1.9-mill tax levy for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, for a period of five years, beginning with the tax list and duplicate for the year 2015, the proceeds of which levy first would be due and collected and made available to the City in calendar year 2016, shall be submitted under the provisions of Sections 5705.19(G) and 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code to the electors of the City of North Ridgeville at an election to be held therein on May 5, 2015, as authorized by law. That election shall be held at the regular places of voting in this City as established by the Board of Elections of Lorain County, or otherwise, within the times provided by law and shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to give or cause to be given notice of that election as provided by law.

Section 4. The Clerk of Council is hereby further directed to certify a copy of this Resolution, together with a certified copy of Resolution No. 1322-2014, adopted on December 15, 2014, and the related County Auditor's certificate, to the Lorain County Board of Elections before the close of business on February 4, 2015.

Section 5. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 6. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that this resolution must be effective immediately so that it can be timely filed with the Board of Elections in order submit the question of the levy to the electors at an election on May 5, 2015; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.

1331-2015 A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE THE QUESTION OF THE RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING TAX FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, AND THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT POLICE PERSONNEL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.19(J) AND 5705.191 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2014, this Council adopted Resolution No. 1323-2014 pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code declaring it necessary to renew an existing 1.95-mill tax levy for the

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purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, and other equipment used directly in the operation of the Police Department of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, and the payment of salaries of permanent police personnel of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, and requesting the Lorain County Auditor to certify the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that renewal levy; and

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2015, the Lorain County Auditor certified that the total current tax valuation of the City is \$715,395,780 and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that 1.95-mill renewal levy would be \$1,375,716 annually during the life of the levy, assuming that the total current tax valuation remains the same throughout the life of the levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, not less than two-thirds of all members of said Council elected thereto concurring, that:

5193-2015 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE PURSUANT TO O.R.C. SECTION 721.15(D) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville, pursuant to O.R.C. Section 721.15(D), may sell certain personal property by Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, North Ridgeville City Ordinance No. 4177-2005 and amending Ordinance No. 4711-09 permit the sale of City-owned personal property via Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department's Flink snow plow (11PA58-APW) has been welded several times and is no longer useful to the City; it is valued in excess of \$1,000.00, therefore the sale of the snow plow must be approved by Council; and

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WHEREAS, the Service Department has no use for this equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council finds that the Flink snow plow (11PA58-APW) no longer serves a municipal purpose and hereby approves the sale of this equipment via Internet auction.

SECTION 2. Proceeds from the sale of the Flink snow plow shall be deposited into the appropriate City fund(s).

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to effectuate the sale in a timely manner to receive the most money from the sale. **WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

5194-2015 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF AVON AND VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD AS REQUESTED BY THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO ENSURE UNIFORM STANDARDS, COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT FOR THE OPERATION OF THE FRENCH CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville owns and operates the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant located in Sheffield Village, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, since the acquisition of the treatment facility from the OWDA in 1983 by the City of North Ridgeville, the City of Avon and Sheffield Village have received wastewater treatment services by the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant pursuant to the terms of agreements executed with North Ridgeville; and

WHEREAS, the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant must obtain and maintain a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit through the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) which inspects the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant and enforces regulations therefore to ensure compliance with required standards; and

WHEREAS, the OEPA has conditioned the current NPDES Permit upon certain conditions and requirements, including an agreement between the cities served as required by Title 40 Part 403.8(f)(1) of the Code of Federal Regulations and Section 3745-3-03(C)(1) of the Ohio Administrative Code to

ensure uniform pretreatment standards and compliance enforcement for the operation of the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Multi-Jurisdictional Agreement between the cities of North Ridgeville, Avon, and Sheffield Village, in the same form of that substantially similar to that which is attached hereto and marked **Exhibit “A”**, and is incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

5195-2015 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF MUNICIPAL REAL PROPERTY AND ACCESSORY STRUCTURES TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE WIDENING AND IMPROVEMENT OF U.S. ROUTE 20 (CENTER RIDGE ROAD).

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Transportation has selected U.S. Route 20 in the City of North Ridgeville for expansion and improvement which shall be primarily funded with State monies via the State of Ohio Transportation Advisory Review Committee; and

WHEREAS, the expansion of the State route will require the acquisition of real property and improvements for the requisite right-of-way and construction; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville owns property which is necessary for the road projects and must be acquired by ODOT in order for the project to proceed as planned; and

WHEREAS, because the City is required to fund a portion of the total cost of the road expansion project which exceeds the maximum amount appropriated by the State, it is in the City’s best interest to donate the requisite property interests to ODOT.

5198-2015 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE PURSUANT TO O.R.C. SECTION 721.15(D).

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville, pursuant to O.R.C. §721.15(D), may sell certain personal property by Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, North Ridgeville City Ordinance No. 4177-2005 and amending Ordinance No. 4711-09 permit the sale of City-owned personal property via Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department's Palatek air compressor, model no. 30D7B, is old and not compatible with current equipment, but is valued in excess of \$1,000.00, therefore the sale of the air compressor must be approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department has no use for this equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council finds that the Palatek air compressor no longer serves a municipal purpose and hereby approves the sale of this equipment via Internet auction.

SECTION 2. Proceeds from the sale of the Palatek air compressor shall be deposited into the appropriate City fund(s).

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in

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meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
