RESOLUTION(S)

1322-2014 A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RENEW AN EXISTING TAX FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS AND BRIDGES IN THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.03, 5705.19(G), AND 5705.191 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, at an election on May 4, 2010, the electors of the City of North Ridgeville approved a 1.9mill tax levy for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, for a period of five years; and

WHEREAS, the authority to levy that 1.9-mill tax will expire with the levy on the 2014 duplicate for collection in calendar year 2015; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the City and that it is necessary to renew the existing 1.9-mill tax in excess of that limitation for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, in order to submit the question of a tax levy pursuant to Sections 5705.19(G) and 5705.191 of the Revised Code, this Council must request that the Lorain County Auditor certify (i) the total current tax valuation of the City and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy; and

WHEREAS, in further accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, upon receipt of a certified copy of a Resolution of this Council declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose, whether it is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, and the section of the Revised Code authorizing its submission to the electors, and requesting such certification, the County

Auditor is to certify the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council declares that it is necessary to renew the City's existing 1.9-mill ad valorem property tax outside of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, and that it intends to submit the question of the renewal of that levy to the electors of the City at an election on May 5, 2015, pursuant to Sections 5705.19(G) and 5705.191 of the Revised Code.

Section 2. This Council requests the Lorain County Auditor to certify to it both (i) the total current tax valuation of the City and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the 1.9-mill renewal levy specified in Section 1.

Section 3. The Clerk of Council of this City is authorized and directed to deliver promptly to the Lorain County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held, in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that Resolution must be effective immediately so that it can be timely filed with the County Auditor and additional proceedings may be timely taken in order to submit the question of the levy to the electors at an election on May 5, 2015. WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.

1323-2014 A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RENEW AN EXISTING TAX FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, AND THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT POLICE PERSONNEL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.03, 5705.19(J), AND 5705.191 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, at an election on May 4, 2010, the electors of the City of North Ridgeville approved a 1.95mill tax levy for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, and other equipment used directly in the operation of the Police Department of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio,

and the payment of salaries of permanent police personnel of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, for a period of five years; and

WHEREAS, the authority to levy that 1.95-mill tax will expire with the levy on the 2014 duplicate for collection in calendar year 2015; and

1325-2014 A RESOLUTION APPROVING ADVANCE REPAYMENTS OF VARIOUS FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND, OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, it becomes necessary for the City's General Fund to advance payments to other funds from time to time with the expectation of repayment:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby approved to repay the prior year advance from the State Grants Fund to the City's General Fund in the amount of Seven-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00).

SECTION 2. That it is hereby approved to repay the prior year advance from the Federal Grants Fund to the City's General Fund in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in

meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of North Ridgeville. WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

1326-2014 A RESOLUTION APPROVING TRANSFERS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, deems it appropriate for the City to transfer funds from the General Fund to other funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby approved to transfer Thirty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$38,585.00) from the General Fund to the Capital Projects Fund.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of North Ridgeville and for the further reason of moving money from one fund to another.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

1327-2014 A RESOLUTION APPROVING TRANSFERS TO THE *PAYROLL AND BENEFITS RESERVE FUND*, OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, deems it appropriate to transfer monies to the *Payroll and Benefits Reserve Fund* from various funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby approved to transfer monies to the *Payroll and Benefits Reserve Fund* from various funds, as follows:

ORDINANCE(S)

5186-2014 AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5156-2014, WHICH INCREASED THE CREDIT FOR TAXES PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, because the proposed tax increase legislation T 73-2014 was not ratified by the voters at the November 4, 2014 election, the commensurate increase in the tax credit as amended by Ordinance No. 5156-2014 is inoperative pursuant to the language of that Ordinance, and is otherwise ineffective.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5156-2014, which increased the credit for taxes paid to another municipality, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to eliminate any confusion or potential litigation that might exist. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

5187-2014 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING, VALUING, AND TAKING IMMEDIATE POSSESSION OF AN INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF WIDENING AND EXPANDING LEAR NAGLE ROAD ACROSS REAL PROPERTY HAVING PERMANENT PARCEL NOS. 07-00-009-113-062 AND 07-00-009-113-024 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2014, the North Ridgeville City Council adopted Resolution No. 1321-2014, declaring the necessity and intent to appropriate an interest in the hereinafter described real estate; and

WHEREAS, City Council, pursuant to O.R.C. §719.05, now deems it necessary to appropriate and take immediate possession of the interest for the purposes as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. A temporary construction easement (as described in attached **Exhibit "A"**), the same being part of two parcels of real estate known as Lorain County permanent Parcel Nos. 07-00-009-113-062 and 07-00-009-113-024, are hereby appropriated for the public purpose of widening and expanding Lear Nagle Road, a road which shall be opened to the public without charge.

SECTION 2. This appropriation is made in accordance with Resolution No. 1321-2014 adopted by the North Ridgeville City Council on December 1, 2014. The same Resolution was served in a manner prescribed by law upon on the record owner of the real property as notice of intent to acquire the necessary property interest on December 8, 2014.

SECTION 3. City Council hereby fixes the value of the property interest, being a temporary construction easement, as well as any damages to the residue at \$300.00, which sum shall be deposited pursuant to Ohio Revised Code \$163.06 with the Clerk of the Lorain County Court of Common Pleas, Probate Division, upon filing of a Petition for Appropriation for the use and benefit of the owner(s) of the real estate being appropriated.

SECTION 4. Upon the deposit of the aforementioned \$300.00, the City of North Ridgeville shall take immediate possession of and enter upon the real estate pursuant to law, in accordance with the terms of the Temporary Easement described in attached **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 5. City Council finds that the appropriation is necessary for the stated public purpose; that the City of North Ridgeville has been unable to agree with the owner(s) as to the purchase of said real

estate *interest*; and that immediate possession of the real estate to be appropriated is necessary for the purpose of making or repairing a road which shall be open to the public without charge.

SECTION 6. The City Law Director is directed to file a Petition for Appropriation in the Lorain County Court of Common Pleas, Probate Division, in order to immediately gain title to the necessary property interest, and to have a jury empanelled to assess the compensation to be paid for interest acquired.

SECTION 7. \$300.00, or so much thereof as may be needed, shall be appropriated from the appropriate fund.

SECTION 8. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the need of moving this eminent domain proceeding forward in a timely manner to meet the terms and needs of the project. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

5188-2014 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 5108-2014, ORDINANCE NO. 5123-2014 AND ORDINANCE NO. 5170-2014 FOR THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2014 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2014 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate certain unanticipated funds and amend other previously appropriated amounts, for the operating of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That to provide for current and other expenditures for the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio for the period commencing January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2014, Ordinance No. 5108-2014, Ordinance No. 5123-2014 and Ordinance No. 5170-2014 be and the same are hereby amended in the following particulars so that from and after the effective date of the Ordinance, the appropriation Ordinance shall include the following, being adjusted for the similar terms in the preceding appropriation Ordinance.
