ORDINANCE(S)

(The following Ordinance(s) were adopted by City Council on December 7, 2015)

5302-2015 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS OF MONEY FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2016 AND ENDING MARCH 31, 2016 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to pass a temporary appropriation Ordinance providing for the current expenses and other expenditures for the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That to provide for current and other expenditures for the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio for the period commencing January 1, 2016 and ending March 31, 2016 the following sums are hereby set aside and appropriated.

SECTION 3. That the Auditor of the City of North Ridgeville be and he is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Treasury of the City of North Ridgeville for payments on any of the foregoing appropriations, upon receiving proper certification and vouchers therefore, approved by officers authorized by law to approve the same or by an Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make the expenditure and provide that no warrants may be drawn or paid for salaries or wages, except to persons employed by authority of or in accordance with law or Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to meet the County Auditor's deadline of December 31, 2015. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

**5303-2015 AN ORDINANCE REPRESENTING REIMBURSEMENT OF
ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES FROM VARIOUS FUNDS OF THE CITY OF
NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, has in existence, various funds for financial purposes; and

WHEREAS, certain costs are paid from funds on behalf of other funds for purposes including administrative and otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, deems it appropriate to reimburse funds for administration expenses and any other expenses incurred.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH
RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That it is hereby deemed necessary to reimburse from the Solid Waste Management Fund to the General Fund for administrative purposes the sum of Thirty Six Thousand Dollars (\$36,000.00).

SECTION 2. That it is hereby deemed necessary to reimburse from the Water Fund to the General Fund for administrative purposes the sum of Seventy Two Thousand Dollars (\$72,000.00).

SECTION 3. That it is hereby deemed necessary to reimburse from the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Fund to the General Fund for administrative purposes the sum of Seventy Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$79,500.00).

SECTION 4. That it is hereby deemed necessary to reimburse from the Sewer Fund to the General Fund for administrative purposes the sum of Seventy Two Thousand Dollars (\$72,000.00).

SECTION 5. That the Auditor and the Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized and directed to reimburse said funds as aforesaid and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate said reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to have things settled by the end of the year. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

5304-2015 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE PURSUANT TO O.R.C. §721.15(D).

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville, pursuant to O.R.C. §721.15(D), may sell certain personal property in a manner authorized by law; and

WHEREAS, North Ridgeville City Ordinance No. 4177-2005 and amending Ordinance No. 4711-09 permit the sale of City-owned personal property via Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, the following City-owned equipment is not being used by the City and no longer serves a municipal purpose: 2009 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN # 2FABP7BV6AX110887 with 107,534 miles; 2010 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN # 2FABP7BV9AX110883 with 123,142 miles; 2005 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN # 2FAFP71W75X114027 with 149,221 miles; and 2005 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN # 2FAFP71W35X114025 with 123,205 miles; and

WHEREAS, each item listed above is valued in excess of \$1,000.00, therefore the sale of this equipment must be approved by City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council finds that the above listed equipment no longer serves a municipal purpose and hereby approves the sale of these assets via Internet auction.

SECTION 2. Proceeds from the sale of the above listed items shall be deposited into the appropriate City fund(s).

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

1369-2015 A RESOLUTION APPROVING ADVANCE REPAYMENTS OF VARIOUS FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio it becomes necessary for the City's General Fund to advance payments to other funds from time to time with the expectation of repayment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby approved to repay the prior year's advance from the Federal Grants Fund to the City's General Fund in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$226,000.00).

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to have things settled by the end of the year. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

1370-2015 A RESOLUTION APPROVING TRANSFERS TO THE *PAYROLL AND BENEFITS RESERVE FUND* OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio deems it appropriate to transfer monies to the *Payroll and Benefits Reserve Fund* from various funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby approved to transfer monies to the *Payroll and Benefits Reserve Fund* from the General Fund in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00).

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to have things settled by the end of the year. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

1371-2015 A RESOLUTION APPROVING ADVANCES FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, it becomes necessary for the City's General Fund to advance payments to other funds from time to time with the expectation of repayment:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby approved to advance funds from the City's General Fund to the Federal Grant Fund in the amount of approximately Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,0000.00) in the year 2015, as needed.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to have things settled by the end of the year. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

1372-2015 A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS TO DEPEW DRILLING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,250.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, O.R.C. §5705.41 provides that City Council may authorize the payment of amounts due, wherein legislation shall be passed within thirty (30) days from receipt of a certificate of the fiscal officer in accordance with O.R.C. §5705.41 (D)(1); and

WHEREAS, the fiscal officer does certify that the expenditure was and is properly appropriated and otherwise lawful, sufficient funds were and are available or in the process of collection to the credit of the proper fund, and the funds were and are free from any previous encumbrance; and

WHEREAS, Depew Drilling, Inc. provided home repair services in accordance with the City's FY2013 CHIP Program, and serves a necessary public purpose.
