RESOLUTION(S)

1446-2019 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE MILDRED STREET EXTENSION FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville has been awarded a Local Transportation Improvement Grant in the amount of \$350,000 by the Ohio Public Works Commission for the extension of Mildred Street; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with §5705.09(F) of the Ohio Revised Code, the City must establish a fund to account for the grant proceeds and related expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established the "*Mildred Street Extension Fund*" to be used to account for the grant proceeds and related program expenditures.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

1447-2019 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE MILLS ROAD BRIDGE PROJECT FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville has been awarded a Federal grant through the Ohio Department of Transportation in the amount of \$912,700 for the Mills Road Bridge Project; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with §5705.09(F) of the Ohio Revised Code, the City must establish a fund to account for the grant proceeds and related expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established the “*Mills Road Bridge Project Fund*” to be used to account for the grant proceeds and related program expenditures.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

1448-2019 A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS REGARDING THE STORM WATER DRAINAGE FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville passed Ordinance 2455-90 creating the Surface Drainage Fund to account for building permit fees to be used to construct, reconstruct, repair, clean and maintain a storm water infrastructure system; and,

WHEREAS, the creation of the Storm Drainage Fund was authorized under §5705.12 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville created a Storm Water Utility by passage of Ordinance 5590-2018, for the purpose of maintaining, improving, and enforcing of the City’s storm water management system and to ensure compliance with State and Federal mandates and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City repealed the surface drainage fee in Ordinance No. 5601-2019, which fee was used for the same purpose as the storm water fee; and

WHEREAS, the Surface Drainage Fund balance may be transferred to the General Fund pursuant to §5705.14(D) of the Ohio Revised Code and money may be transferred from the General Fund to any other fund of the subdivision pursuant to Section 5705.14(E) of the Ohio revised Code; and

WHEREAS, it’s the desire of City Council that the money collected for surface drainage be used for its intended purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The balance of the Surface Drainage Fund after the effective date of Ordinance 5601-2019 and upon payment of any outstanding obligations of the fund shall be transferred to the General Fund pursuant to §5704.14(D) of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2. The Auditor is hereby authorized to transfer from the General Fund to the Storm Water Management Fund an amount equal to that transferred to the General Fund from the Surface Drainage Fund upon termination of that activity.

SECTION 3. The Auditor, upon transfer of the residual balance, shall close the Surface Drainage Fund.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

1449-2019 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FUND TRANSFER AND ADVANCES.

WHEREAS, the appropriated budget for 2019 provided for transfers and advances between certain City Funds; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, deems it appropriate to transfer and advance funds with the appropriate approval where necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

AN ORDINANCE COOPERATING WITH THE DIRECTOR OF THE OHIO
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PERFORM A BRIDGE
REPLACEMENT ON US ROUTE 0020 AT SLM 24.97 AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of City Council and upon the recommendation of the Ohio Department of Transportation, it would be conducive to the public welfare and safety of the motoring public to replace the bridge US Route 0020 at SLM 24.97; and

WHEREAS, upon passage of this Ordinance, the Engineer shall return two (2) original signature copies to Jerry A. Bantz, E.I., Transportation Engineer 2, ODOT District 3 Office of Planning, 906 Clark Avenue Ashland, Ohio 44805.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1 – Project Description

The State has identified the need for the described project:

To perform a bridge replacement on US Route 0020 at SLM 24.97 over a tributary of French Creek in the City of North Ridgeville, in Lorain County.

This project is currently scheduled to be constructed in the summer of 2024.

SECTION 2 – Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the City gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above-described project.

SECTION 3 – Cooperation Statement

The City shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

- 1) The City gives consent for the above improvement; and
- 2) No funds are required from the City except that the City agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost for added construction items requested by the City and not necessary for the improvement as determined by the State and the Federal Highway Administration.

SECTION 4 – Maintenance

Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the City shall:

- 1) Provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law;
- 2) Provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described project; and
- 3) Maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION 5 – Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

If City-owned utilities, within a corporation limit or in a private easement outside corporation limits, need to be relocated due to this ODOT project, the City will be reimbursed for any relocation work; ODOT will perform the coordination, relocation, and reimbursement which shall comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

If other public and private utilities need to be relocated due to this ODOT project, they will not be reimbursed for relocation; with exceptions due to an easement, etc.

SECTION 6 – Authority to Sign

The Mayor of said City of North Ridgeville is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of North Ridgeville to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above-described project.

SECTION 7 – Legal Requirements

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 8 – Effective Date

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to meet the ODOT deadline of March 20, 2019. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

5611-2019 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE H.B. 529 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT COMMUNITY RECREATION GRANT FOR THE MILLS CREEK CONSERVATION AND FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT ROUND 2.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville has experienced stormwater flooding over the regional area, and in particular, in the Pitts Boulevard and Gina Drive area and the Mills Creek watershed; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville applied to the State of Ohio for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 H.B. 529 Capital Budget funding and received an offer of a grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for \$400,000.00 for the H.B. 529 Capital Improvement Community Recreation Flood Mitigation Project entitled Mill Creek Conservation and Flood Control Round 2; and

WHEREAS, the project will include 40 million gallons of stormwater detention, addresses stormwater quality, create aquatic wildlife habitat, create a new riparian corridor, add waterfalls and aquatic plants and create 5,000 linear feet of walking trails throughout a conservation area; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville shall contribute a total of \$40,000.00 towards this project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of North Ridgeville has received an offer of a grant of state funds in a maximum amount of \$400,000.00 from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources.

SECTION 2. The Mayor of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the Mill Creek Conservation and Flood Control Project Round 2.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from an after the earliest period allowed by law.

5612-2019 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE PURSUANT TO O.R.C. SECTION 721.15(D).

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville, pursuant to O.R.C. §721.15(D), may sell certain personal property by Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, North Ridgeville City Ordinance No. 4177-2005 and amending Ordinance No. 4711-09 permit the sale of City-owned personal property via Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department's Station 2 generator, which has been replaced by a new generator, is valued in excess of \$1,000.00, therefore the sale of the asset must be approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, the cost of an outdoor enclosure to move the generator outside of the building was not as cost effective as the purchase of a new outdoor generator.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council finds that the old Fire Station 2 generator no longer serves a municipal purpose and hereby approves the sale of the old generator via Internet auction.

SECTION 2. Proceeds from the sale of the old generator shall be deposited into the appropriate City fund(s).

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

5613-2019 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, ACCORDING TO LAW AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY LAW, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE WESTFIELD WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT DECOMMISSIONING WATER AND SEWER EXTENSION PROJECT AND OTHER APPURTENANCES, NOT TO EXCEED \$3,189,238.09 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Westfield Wastewater Treatment Plant, west of Westfield Drive, services the residents of the Westfield Allotment and has served its useful life; and

WHEREAS, the decommissioning of the Westfield Wastewater Treatment Plant will require the connection of the existing eight inch sanitary sewer along Westfield Drive to the westerly sanitary trunk sewer in order to provide conveyance for the Westfield Subdivision sewage; and

WHEREAS, the existing six inch water main on Westfield Drive is a dead-end water main and should be looped to provide increased reliability of service and reduce head losses; and

WHEREAS, bidding documents for the demolition and construction work of the Westfield Wastewater Treatment Plant Decommissioning Water and Sewer Extension Project will be available in the Engineering Department for this project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, according to law and in a manner prescribed by law, with the lowest and best bidder for the Westfield Wastewater Treatment Plant Decommissioning Water and Sewer Extension Project and other appurtenances in an amount not to exceed \$3,189,238.09.

SECTION 2. The cost for said project shall be paid from the appropriate fund.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate to take the trees down by April 1, 2019. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

5614-2019 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, ACCORDING TO LAW AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY LAW, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE 2019 CRACK SEAL PROJECT AND OTHER APPURTENANCES, NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000.00.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville Service Department has identified the need to crack seal roadways within Ridgefield Subdivision and Waterbury Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, this routine maintenance project will prolong the life of the pavements within these subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the estimated amount of lane miles to be crack sealed with this project is approximately thirty (30) lane miles; and

WHEREAS, bidding documents will be available through the Engineering Department for this project; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, according to law and in a manner prescribed by law, with the lowest and best bidder for the 2019 Crack Seal Project and other appurtenances in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00.

SECTION 2. The cost for said project shall be paid from the appropriate fund.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from an after the earliest period allowed by law.

5615-2019 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING N.R.C.O. SECTION 1640.01 PURPOSE IN ORDER TO CONFORM TO THE CURRENT OHIO FIRE CODE.

WHEREAS, the North Ridgeville Fire Department follows the most current edition of the Ohio Fire Code, and from time to time the City's regulations need to be updated to reflect current regulations;

WHEREAS, N.R.C.O. §1640.01 *Purpose* of the North Ridgeville fire regulations has not been updated since 1999 and conflicts with current Ohio Fire Code §912.2. §1640.01 currently reads as follows:

1640.01 (i) All fire hydrants and Fire Department connections shall be placed not closer than fifty feet from all buildings protected unless otherwise permitted by the Fire Chief. Check valves for Fire Department connections shall be accessible with the installation of a pit, which shall have proper drainage as per the City Engineer. Wall hydrants and wall Fire Department connections on the building are prohibited.

WHEREAS, §912.2 of the current Ohio Fire Code reads as follows:

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912.2 Location. With respect to hydrants, driveways, buildings and landscaping, fire department connections shall be so located that fire apparatus and hose connected to supply the system will not obstruct access to the buildings for other fire apparatus. The location of the fire department connections shall be approved by the fire code official. After approving the location of the fire department connection(s), the fire code official shall submit this approval to the building code official of the certified building department having jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, N.R.C.O. §1640.01 needs to be amended to reflect the current Ohio Fire Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. N.R.C.O. §1640.01(i) shall be amended as follows:

1640.01 (i) All fire hydrants and Fire Department connections shall be placed not closer than fifty feet from all buildings protected unless otherwise permitted by the Fire Chief. Check valves for Fire Department connections shall be accessible with the installation of a pit, which shall have proper drainage as per the City Engineer. The location of the Fire Department connections shall be approved by the Fire Code Official.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

5616-2019 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING N.R.C.O. SECTION 1610.01 1993 EDITION ADOPTED; PURPOSE; FILE AND DISTRIBUTION COPIES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville uses the Ohio Fire Code as the Fire Prevention Code;

WHEREAS, N.R.C.O. §1610.01 currently states the following:

1610.01 1993 EDITION ADOPTED; PURPOSE; FILE AND DISTRIBUTION COPIES.

(a) Pursuant to Section 3.15 of the City Charter, the BOCA National Fire Prevention Code, 1993 edition, as published by Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., is hereby adopted as the Fire Prevention Code of the City, save and except for such portions thereof as may be amended or repealed in this chapter. The purpose of the BOCA National Fire Prevention Code is to prescribe

regulations for the control of buildings, structures and premises as therein provided for the safeguarding, to a reasonable degree, of life and property from the hazards of fire and explosion arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the use or occupancy of buildings or premises. Compliance with standards of the BOCA National Fire Prevention Code, the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal, or other approved nationally recognized standards, shall be deemed to be prima-facie evidence of compliance with the purposes of this section.

WHEREAS, the City desires to update its Ordinances to reflect use of the current Ohio Fire Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. N.R.C.O. §1610.01 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

1610.01 Ohio Fire Code Adopted; Purpose

Pursuant to Section 3.15 of the City Charter, Council may adopt standard Ordinances and codes prepared by public or private agencies on such matters as fire prevention. The most current edition of the Ohio Fire Code is hereby adopted as the fire prevention code of the City, save and except for such portions thereof as may be amended or repealed in the Chapter.

The purpose of the Ohio Fire Code is to prescribe regulation for the control of buildings, structures and premises as therein provided for the safeguarding, to a reasonable degree, of life and property from the hazards of fire and explosion.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

5617-2019 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, ACCORDING TO LAW AND IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY LAW, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE 2019 CATCH BASIN REHABILITATION PROJECT AND OTHER APPURTENANCES, NOT TO EXCEED \$125,000.00.

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville Service Department has identified the need to rehabilitate and/or reconstruct various catch basins throughout the City that are in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville has appropriated the necessary funds to perform this work; and

WHEREAS, the estimated amount of catch basins to be repaired is approximately 60; and

WHEREAS, the bidding documents and specifications will be available through the Engineering Department for this project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, according to law and in a manner prescribed by law, with the lowest and best bidder for the 2019 Catch Basin Rehabilitation Project and other appurtenances in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00.

SECTION 2. The cost for said project shall be paid from the appropriate fund(s).

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from an after the earliest period allowed by law.
