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## RESOLUTION(S)

**1494-2020 A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE'S SHARE OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY CORONAVIRUS RELIEF DISTRIBUTION FUND AND AFFIRMING THAT UPON RECEIPT THEREOF SUCH FUNDS SHALL BE USED ONLY TO COVER COSTS INCURRED BY THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF APPLICABLE LAW AND REGULATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136 (the Cares Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in Senate Bill 310 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly (S.B. 310); and

**WHEREAS**, S.B. 310 requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the Cares Act. to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the Cares Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d) and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio is requesting its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City of North Ridgeville affirms that all funds received from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund pursuant to S.B. 310 be expended only to cover the costs of the City of North Ridgeville consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the Cares Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidelines only to cover expenses that:

- (1) Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (2) Were not accounted for in the City of North Ridgeville's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- (3) Were incurred during the period that begins March 1, 2020 and ends on December 31, 2020.

**SECTION 2.** That in compliance with S.B. 310, it is further resolved that the City's Finance Officer/Auditor take all necessary action to:

- (1) On or before October 15, 2020, pay any unencumbered balance of money in the City of North Ridgeville's Local Coronavirus Relief Fund to the Lorain County Treasurer;
- (2) On or before December 28, 2020, pay the balance of any money in the City of North Ridgeville's Local Coronavirus Relief Fund to the state treasury in the manner prescribed by the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management; and
- (3) Provide any information related to payments received under S.B. 310 to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management as requested.

**SECTION 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure; the emergency being in order to make certain the Resolution is in place in order to receive the funds. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

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**ORDINANCE(S)**

**5752-2020 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5743-2020 ACCEPTING THE NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL (NOPEC) 2020 ENERGIZED COMMUNITY GRANT(S), AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A NEW 2020 GRANT AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, is a member of the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) and is eligible for one or more NOPEC Energized Community Grant(s) for 2020 (NEC Grant(s)) as provided for in the NEC Grant Program guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 5743-2020 was passed on May 18, 2020, accepting the 2020 Energized Community Grant, with the assumption that the 2018 Grant Agreement was still in effect; and

**WHEREAS**, NOPEC, Inc. is requesting that a new 2020 Energized Community Grant Agreement be entered into and executed in substantially the same form as the Grant Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”**.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** City Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into the Grant Agreement to accept the NEC Grant(s) for 2020, and hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Grant Agreement to accept the NEC Grant(s) funds.

**SECTION 2.** The Grant Agreement shall begin January 1, 2020 and expire on December 31, 2020, and shall be automatically renewed annually under the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement.

**SECTION 3.** The NEC Grant(s) shall be deposited and applied to the appropriate fund(s).

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being in order to meet the grant deadline of June 30, 2020. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

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**5753-2020      AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A FIVE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH HACH COMPANY FOR THE FRENCH CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT BILLING METERS RENEWAL PROJECT, NOT TO EXCEED \$178,500.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant receives flow from North Ridgeville, Avon and Sheffield Village which must be monitored for operational and billing purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the French Creek Plant Sanitary Sewer District have approved the use of data collected by the third party vendor, Hach Company; and

**WHEREAS**, Hach Company will install, maintain and monitor all ultrasonic flow meters throughout the French Creek Plant Sewer Service Area.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a five-year contract with Hach Company in substantially the same form as **Exhibit “A”** attached hereto, for the French Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant Billing Meters Renewal project, not to exceed \$178,500.00.

**SECTION 2.** The contract shall go into effect on July 14, 2020 and end July 14, 2025.

**SECTION 3.** The costs for this project shall be charged to and paid from the appropriate City fund.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being in order ensure proper and accurate billing to other communities. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
