LEGAL NOTICE

Sealed proposals will be received at the Office of the Mayor, City Hall, 7307 Avon Belden Road, North Ridgeville, Ohio 44039 until 11:00 A.M. (Local Time) on May 9, 2018 and will be opened and read immediately thereafter for the:

2,000,000 GALLON FLUTED COLUMN ELEVATED WATER STORAGE TANK REHABILITATION PROJECT

The work will consist of an exterior high pressure water clean (5,000 to 10,000 psi), spot power tool clean to a SSPC-SP11 standard, and application of a three (3) coat epoxy urethane system. The foundation will receive water clean and a two (2) coat epoxy system. Miscellaneous repairs will include the installation of a handhold at the wet interior roof hatch, the installation of an overflow flap gate, installation of a mud valve, installation of a fall protection device on the dry interior column ladders, the installation of a roof painter's rail, and replacement of dry interior and aviation light bulbs.

Bidders will be required to use the printed bid forms, which will be available along with the bid specifications from:

- 1) The office of the City Engineer, City Hall 7307 Avon Belden Road, North Ridgeville, Ohio 44039. Checks shall be made payable to the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, at a non-refundable cost of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) picked up. No documents will be mailed.
- 2) The office of Dixon Engineering, Inc., 1104 Third Avenue, Lake Odessa, Michigan, 48849 upon payment of \$65.00 (handling charge for each set). Payment for SPECIFICATIONS received from Dixon Engineering should be made to Dixon Engineering, Incorporated. There will be no refund of handling charge for return of specification packages.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid guarantee which shall consist of an Ohio Statutory Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond, substantially in the form prescribed by ORC 153.57 in a penal amount equal to or greater than 100% of the bid price. No other form of bond is acceptable. Bid security furnished in bond form shall be issued by a surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

The City of North Ridgeville, Ohio reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

Sealed bids must be marked on the front of the envelope: "2,000,000 Gallon Fluted column Elevated water Storage Tank Rehabilitation Project"

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the Equal Employment Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code, Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9, shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Lorain County and the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, as determined by the Department of Commerce, Division of Labor and Worker Safety, Bureau of Wage and Hour.
