**RESOLUTION NO. 1599-2023**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FUND TRANSFERS AND ADVANCES,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, deems it appropriate to transfer and advance funds with the appropriate approval where necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council approved Resolution 1598-2023 on June 5, 2023, authorizing the acceptance of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency 2023 Community and Litter Grant for recycling promotion and education for the funding period of July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024, in the amount of \$10,240.00 and a 25% local match; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council authorizes a transfer from the General Fund to the State Grant Fund in the amount of \$2,560.00 for the 25% local match obligation; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council authorizes an advance from the General Fund to the State Grant Fund in the amount of \$5,120.00 which shall be reimbursed by the grantor after final grant reporting is completed. Once reimbursement is received the funds shall be placed in the General Fund.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The Director of Finance is authorized to transfer funds not to exceed the following amounts:

**RESOLUTION NO. 1600-2023**

**AN RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATES BY THE CITY FISCAL OFFICER AND THE PAYMENT OF AMOUNTS DUE FOR VARIOUS PURCHASE ORDERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(D)(1), the City may not enter into any contract or give any order involving the expenditure of money unless there is attached thereto a certificate of the City’s Fiscal Officer that the amount required to meet the obligation has been lawfully appropriated for such purpose and is in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(D)(1) further provides that in such circumstances when no certificate is furnished as required and the expenditure is for \$3,000.00 or more, the City’s Council, as the City’s taxing authority, may authorize the drawing of a warrant in payment of amounts due upon such contract or order upon certification by the City’s Fiscal Officer that there was at the time of the execution of such certificate a sufficient sum appropriated for the purpose of such contract in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 16, 2022, City Council adopted Ordinance 5951-2022 deeming it to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the City to approve the execution by the City Fiscal Officer of Then and Now Certifications, and to authorize payment of amounts due under the contracts or orders requiring the expenditure of \$3,000.00 up to \$20,000.00;

**WHEREAS**, on May 16, 2022, City Council adopted Ordinance 5951-2022 City Council also deemed it necessary to review and approve the execution by the City Fiscal Officer of Then and Now Certifications and authorize payments of amounts due under contracts or order which exceeds \$20,000.00;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** City Council, pursuant to Ordinance 5951-2022 adopted May 16, 2022, hereby approves the execution of Then and Now Certificates by the Fiscal Officer and authorizes payment due and owing as shown in Exhibit A attached and incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being in order to provide the Department of Finance with the resources necessary to meet its obligations. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

**ORDINANCE NO. 6082-2023**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Ridgeville has a number of vehicles/equipment which are obsolete, and/or not needed, and/or unfit for public use; and

**WHEREAS**, the sale of such property is one of the powers of local self-government, conferred by Section 3, Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution when exercised in conjunction with the general law; and

**WHEREAS**, O.R.C. §721.15(A) provides that such sale be authorized by the passage of an authorizing ordinance when the estimated value of the property is more than \$1,000.00, that the vehicle/equipment goes to the highest and best bidder, and that the sale be advertised as required under the statute; and

**WHEREAS**, the North Ridgeville City Council finds that the value of each vehicle/equipment is more than \$1,000.00; and further finds that due to the large number of vehicles/equipment, the sale will better be accomplished through trade-in or the services of the Greater Cleveland Auto Auction, and that such sale is also required to comply with O.R.C. §721.15(A).

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** City Council finds the following vehicles/equipment no longer serve a municipal purpose and hereby approves the sale or trade-in of the obsolete/unneeded/unfit vehicles/equipment in the manner authorized by law and the proceeds be deposited into the appropriate account:

**ORDINANCE NO. 6083-2023**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 6031-2022 OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, PROVIDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2023, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2023, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend the appropriations for certain funds and appropriate other amounts for the operations of the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That to provide for current and other expenditures for the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio for the period commencing January 1, 2023, and ending December 31, 2023, Ordinance No. 6031-2022 be and the same is hereby supplemented in the following amounts so that from and after the effective date of the Ordinance, the appropriation Ordinance shall include the following, being adjusted for the similar terms in the preceding appropriation Ordinance.

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


