**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being in order to meet the administration's office equipment needs before the end of the year. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
