



# FREE ASSISTANCE to Reduce or Remove Lead Hazards from your Home!

## Owner Occupied Home Repair:

- Grant-Funded: No cost to the homeowner.
- May be able to include an additional home repair.
- Temporary relocation may be required while project is underway depending on the extent of work required.

## FACTS ABOUT LEAD:

- Lead can affect children's brains and developing nervous systems, causing reduced IQ, learning disabilities, and behavior problems. Lead is also harmful to adults.
- Lead in dust is the most common way people are exposed to lead. People can also get lead in their bodies from lead in soil or paint chips. Lead dust is often invisible.
- Lead-based paint was used in more than 38 million homes until it was banned for residential use in 1978.
- Projects that disturb surfaces can create dust and endanger you and your family. Don't let this happen to you.


