

General Information

Time of Collection: To ensure your recycling and rubbish materials removal, please place your rubbish and recycling container at curb by **6 AM**.



Day of Collection: Recycling and rubbish materials will be picked up on the same day each week EXCEPT when a holiday falls on or before your regular pick up day. Then your recycling and rubbish materials will be collected one day late.

2021 Holidays That Affect Collections are the Following:

Memorial Day, Fourth of July and Labor Day

Containers:

The standard household will receive a 95-gallon trash container and a 65-gallon recycle container. Seniors will be delivered a 65-gallon trash container and 65-gallon recycle container unless another size trash container is requested. Contact Allied Waste for details at 440-458-5191.

Container Placement: Place containers within 3 feet of the curb and 3 feet apart, with the arrows facing the street. Do not place carts near mailboxes or other fixed objects.

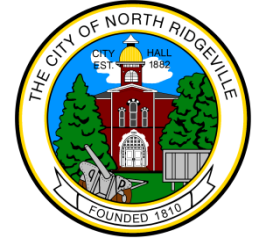
Note: Do not place containers at the curb prior to 5 PM on the day before collection. Please remove empty containers within 12 hours after collection.

Rubbish Collection Rules and Regulations for Single Family Homes and Condos

A blue 95-gallon trash container and a green 65-gallon recycle container should already be at the property unless you're moving into new construction. In that case, please call 440-458-5191 to request delivery of your containers.

PERMITTED REFUSE:

- Food Waste - drained, wrapped and placed in plastic bag.
- Other trash - juice boxes, paper containers, waste paper, etc.
- Sharp items, broken glass, syringes, etc. Place in puncture-proof container prior to placing in cart.

BULK TRASH COLLECTION (MONTHLY) ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Household furniture, carpeting, tied and rolled in 3-4' lengths and no more than 50 pounds each, etc.
- Boxes, broken down no more than 4 ft. lengths
- Mattresses & box springs must be bagged for disposal
- Glass (mirrors, etc.) taped in asterisk shape
- Tables, swing sets, and television sets, etc.
- Refrigerators, freezer, washers and dryers - DOORS REMOVED
- Window AC Units and Dehumidifiers
- Stoves and Dishwashers
- Trash cans or bags of trash, under 50 pounds each.
- Christmas trees picked up the first and second full week in January

Bulk items will be picked up based on where you live – see the 2021 schedule below:

Homes on Route 83 and East of Route 83

January 5	July 7
February 2	August 3
March 2	September 8
April 6	October 5
May 4	November 2
June 8	December 7

Homes West of Route 83

January 12	July 13
February 9	August 10
March 9	September 14
April 13	October 12
May 11	November 9
June 15	December 14

Recycling Collection Rules & Regulations

A green 65-gallon container will be provided for all your recyclable materials which include:

Cardboard boxes, newspapers, junk-mail, magazines, cereal boxes, glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, and plastics (#1-7). Place all items loose in recycling container.



DAMAGED CARTS: All trash and recycling containers are property of Allied Waste. If you should experience damage to either of them (missing wheel, broken lid, etc.), please call 440-353-0841 for repairs or replacement.

Please DO NOT jam trash or recycled items into or overstuff your containers as they may not empty properly!

Items excluded from Recycling Collections

Yard waste, plastic bags, shredded paper, window glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses, Styrofoam, aluminum foil, mirrors or ceramics and empty plastic containers that had contained motor oil, antifreeze, pesticides and herbicides. Place above items and empty containers in trash container.

Yard Waste Rules and Regulations

Separate yard waste collection will take place beginning April 6th through November 23, 2021 on your regular pick-up day. Christmas trees will be collected the first and second week of January.

GRASS CLIPPINGS AND OTHER YARD WASTE FOR COMPOSTING:

All grass clippings and other yard waste should be placed in brown paper yard waste bags not to exceed 50 lbs.

BRUSH AND SMALL TREE TRIMMINGS:

Must be cut, bundled, and securely tied not exceeding 4 feet in length or 50 lbs. (NO WIRE, PLEASE)

LEAF PICK-UP:

Leaves may be placed at the curb in plastic bags beginning October 26th through November 23, 2021 on your regular pick-up day.

Grass clippings and other yard waste may be placed in trash cart and will be collected with the rubbish materials.

Note: Landscapers and tree services are responsible for removal of any yard waste they generate while working at a residence.
