

General Information

Time of Collection:

To ensure your recycling and rubbish material removal, please place your rubbish and recycling container at the curb by **6 a.m.**

Day of Collection:

Recycling, yard waste, bulk and rubbish materials will be picked up on the same day each week EXCEPT when a holiday falls on or before your regular pick up day. Then your recycling, yard waste, bulk and rubbish materials will be collected one day late.

Holidays That Affect Collections:

New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Containers:

The standard household will receive a 95-gallon trash container and a 65-gallon recycle container. A 65-gallon trash container is available upon request.

Container Placement:

Place containers within 3 feet of the curb and 3 feet apart, with the arrows facing the street. Do not place carts near mailboxes or other fixed objects.

Note: Do not place containers at the curb prior to 5 p.m. on the day before collection. Please remove empty containers within 12 hours after collection.

Rubbish Collection Rules and Regulations for Single Family Homes and Condos

A blue 95-gallon trash container and a green 65-gallon recycle container should already be at the property unless you're moving into new construction. Contact the Utilities Department at (440) 490-2049 to request delivery of your containers.

PERMITTED REFUSE:

- Food Waste - drained, wrapped and placed in plastic bag.
- Other trash - juice boxes, paper containers, waste paper, etc.
- Sharp items, broken glass, syringes, etc. Place in puncture-proof container prior to placing in cart.

WEEKLY BULK TRASH COLLECTION ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE (NO MORE THAN 4 ITEMS PER WEEK):

- Household furniture, carpeting, tied and rolled in 3 to 4-foot lengths and no more than 50 pounds each, etc.
- Boxes, broken down no more than 4-foot lengths
- Mattresses and box springs must be bagged for disposal
- Glass (mirrors, etc.) taped in asterisk shape
- Tables, swing sets, television sets, etc.
- Refrigerators, freezer, washers and dryers - DOORS REMOVED
- Window AC units and dehumidifiers
- Stoves and dishwashers
- Trash cans or bags of trash, under 50 pounds each
- Christmas trees picked up the first and second full week in January

Recycling Collection Rules and Regulations

A green 65-gallon container will be provided for all your recyclable materials which include:

Cardboard boxes, newspapers, junk mail, magazines, cereal boxes, glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, and plastics (#1-7). Place all items loose in recycling container.



Items Excluded from Recycling Collections

Yard waste, plastic bags, shredded paper, window glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses, Styrofoam, aluminum foil, mirrors or ceramics and empty plastic containers that had contained motor oil, antifreeze, pesticides and herbicides. Place above items and empty containers in trash container.

Damaged Carts

All trash and recycling containers are property of Allied Waste Services. If you should experience damage to either of them (missing wheel, broken lid, etc.), please contact the Utilities Department at (440) 490-2049 for repairs or replacement.

Please DO NOT jam trash or recycled items into or overstuff your containers as they may not empty properly!

Yard Waste Rules and Regulations

Yard waste (grass clippings, leaves) will be picked up weekly on your regular service day all year long. Place yard waste in clear plastic bags, brown paper yard waste bags or loose in a trash container, not to exceed 32 gallons and clearly marked as "yard waste." Christmas trees will be collected the first and second week of January.

BRUSH AND SMALL TREE TRIMMINGS:

Must be cut, bundled and securely tied not exceeding 4 feet in length or 50 pounds (NO WIRE, PLEASE).
