A Message from Republic Services

We are excited to announce that beginning the first week of May 2022, we will begin providing you with weekly bulk collection services on your regular service day. Since we are increasing bulk collections from one week per month to a weekly collection, we would ask that bulk items be limited to four (4) items on the weekly collection day.

In addition, we will now collect your yard waste materials along with the bulk items on a weekly basis throughout the year.

Bulk Waste

The items below are picked up on your regular scheduled pickup day:

- > Household furniture and carpeting tied and rolled into 4' lengths
- > Tables, swing sets (disassembled), TVs and appliances
- > Additional items can be found on our website at Nridgeville.org

The items below are not accepted curbside:

- > Large car parts including tires, tail pipes and mufflers
- > Construction material
- > Liquids
- > Motor oil, antifreeze, pesticides, herbicides etc.

Note: Contractors performing home repairs and remodeling services are responsible for the removal of building materials and debris.

Yard Waste

Grass clippings can be placed in clear plastic bags, yard waste bags or loose in a trash container, not to exceed 32 gallons and clearly marked as "yard waste" (yard waste bags are not required). Small branches must be bundled and tied in no more than 4' lengths or 35 lbs.

Day of Collection

Your collection day for all materials will continue to be weekly on Tuesday, unless a holiday falls before or on your regular collection day for that week only.

Holidays That Affect Collection

Items that can always be placed in your recycling cart include:

Items that can never be placed in your recycling cart include:



Did you know a single dirty ketchup bottle within your recycling cart can contaminate an entire truckload of otherwise reusable recyclables?

These items should be empty, clean and dry before placing them in your recycling cart.

Did you know that plastic bags are never recyclable? Consider taking them back to your local grocery store to recycle them.

Plastic bags should never be placed in your recycling cart.
