The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District is conducting a Flood Insurance Study of French Creek in the Towns of Sheffield, Avon, and North Ridgeville. In order to complete that study we will have our survey crews in the field collecting existing ground elevations along the creek, starting at Black Creek and ending at Stearns Road.

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District field personnel will be carrying their USACE ID cards, and driving in US Government trucks, They will be working Monday thru Friday between the hours of 7:00am to 5:00pm, and there for the next month.

They are collecting ground elevations along pre-set cross-section lines along the creek that are required by the hydraulic engineers so they can construct their hydraulic model to do the flood study. The extent of the field work is non-intrusive and should not require any line clearing or setting of permanent survey control stakes.

My intent of this correspondence is to put you on notice in case you receive any calls from property owners located within the study area.
