LORAIN COUNTY PARTNERS RECEIVE \$1,062,500.00 GRANT

LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO USA - The Lorain County Commissioners are pleased to announce that Lorain County, in partnership with the cities of Oberlin and Sheffield Lake, have been awarded \$1,062,500 in funding from the Ohio Development Services Agency Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Grant. As partners, each community has funds designated to address home repair and rehabilitation of privately owned-owner occupied housing.

Commissioner Lori Kokoski stated, "The CHIP funds are vital to keeping people in their homes, protecting property values, and protecting the environment. Local contractors are able to perform needed repairs such as furnace replacements, septic system repairs and roof replacements".

The CHIP grant funding awarded provides home repair and rehabilitation for homes located in Lorain County townships, villages and the cities of Amherst, Avon, Avon Lake, North Ridgeville, Oberlin and Sheffield Lake. In addition to residing in these communities, homeowners must meet income eligibility requirements and project eligibility requirements.
