**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2725-93, AND
SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO, IN ORDER TO ELIMINATE
THE WAGE INCREASE PARITY PROVISIONS FOR ALL NON-UNION
MEMBERS.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2725-93, and subsequent amendments thereto, provided for wage parity between union and non-union employees; and

WHEREAS, if any union and/or all unions bargained for an annual wage increase for its members, Ordinance 2725-93 and subsequent amendments thereto, provided for that same annual wage increase to non-union employees; and

WHEREAS, since 1993, non-union employees have also been able to receive a merit increase in addition to any wage parity increase; and

WHEREAS, City Council and the Administration wish to amend Ordinance No. 2725-93, and subsequent amendments thereto, to remove the wage parity provisions between non-union employees and union members; and

WHEREAS, City Council and the Administration wish to continue to provide for merit increases to non-union employees when deemed appropriate.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2725-93, and subsequent amendments thereto, are amended by removal of any wage parity provisions with and and/or all union contracts.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 5596-2018 states “The annual salaries shall increase periodically in the same percentage as that average percentage increase in wages as is from time to time negotiated by the various collective bargaining units of the City of North Ridgeville in order to maintain wage parity, within said ranges;” and

WHEREAS, City Council and the Administration wish to remove the wage parity provision between non-union employees and union members.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5596-2018 is hereby amended by removing the wage parity provision contained in Section 2.
