There was not a quorum of seven members present. This is the second meeting where a quorum was not met.

Chairman Scott Wangler received a letter from Gayle Manning, State Senator, 13th District, congratulating the City on receiving capital funds from the Capital Budget Bill, SB 310. The City initially asked for a 4 million dollar grant through the ODNR for the improvement of our drainage issues throughout the city. The amount allocated will be disclosed after August 16, 2016, and ODNR will be keeping us informed about the distribution process.

Chairman Scott Wangler also advised about the drainage improvements for the area behind Noll & Behm and that the sanitary line will be heading north, not going through Behm. Valore Builders will be building a new subdivision in the very near future.

Sidewalks have been installed on Aurensen Road after receiving a grant through Lorain County Health Department, with the grant portion of \$35,810. A camouflage camera has been installed to document resident traffic on the new sidewalks, as that was a requirement in receiving the grant.

Board Member Dennis Boose asked if the Service Department had been notified concerning the cleaning of the ditch North of Deborah Drive again, as the debris has fallen back into the ditch due to the debris being left on the banks of the ditch.

A resident on Schoolhouse Lane wanted to have a small tree removed which fell into ditch on the north side, abutting Greenwich Avenue. Maintenance Department of the Muirwood Village Condos were taking their time removing it, so Member Dennis Boose went to remove a small tree.

Board Member Mario Cipriano requested to have the French Creek Flood Study Recommendation Map emailed to him.

Board Members Mario Cipriano and Dennis Boose suggested a letter, from the Chairman, be sent to board members reminding them of the importance of this committee.

Discussion ended approximately at 7:30pm.
