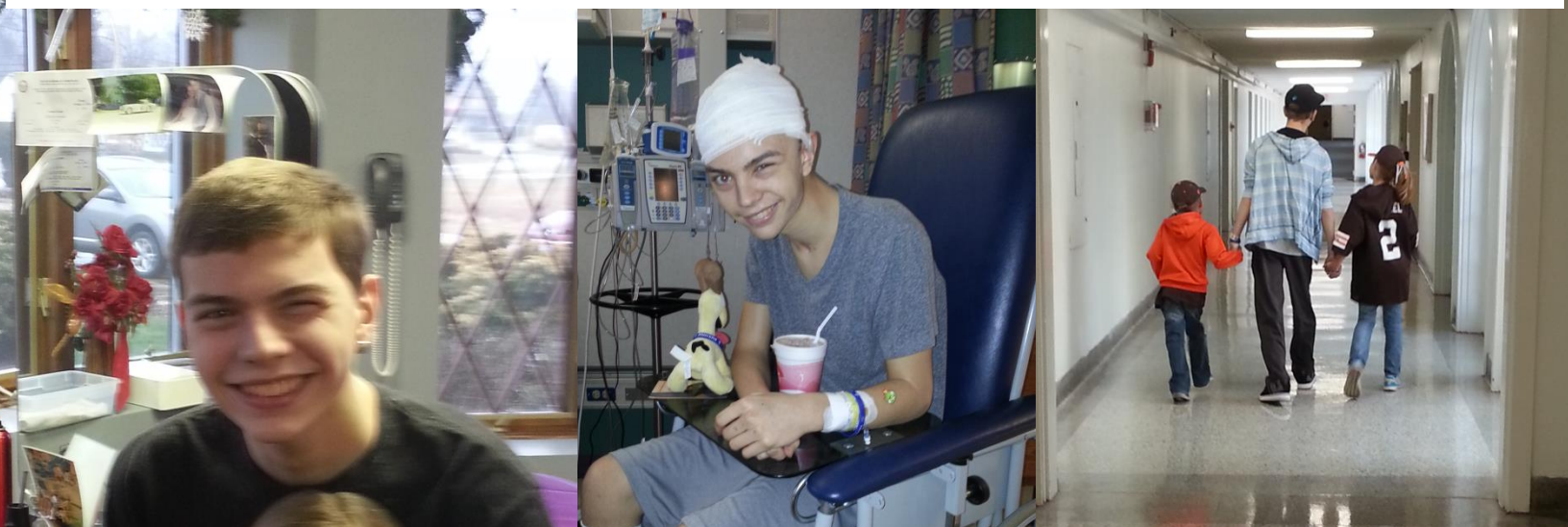


# Dance for Life ZUMBATHON

**Bio:** Andrew Ody was a typical American teenager. He is the son of North Ridgeville Police Officer Chris Ody and Erin Miles. Andrew was looking forward to finishing high school, joining the Coast Guard and going to college. Then, in July 2014, a tragic accident changed his world forever. Andrew was enjoying a weekend away with family and friends to celebrate his 17<sup>th</sup> birthday when he fell off the back of a golf cart and was Life Flighted to the hospital. Andrew suffered a Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI), requiring emergency surgery to remove part of his skull to relieve pressure in his brain. He required life support and was in a coma for weeks. Doctors were not hopeful for any type of recovery, but Andrew is a fighter and was not ready to leave this earth. His TBI has left him with right sided weakness, cognitive delays and aphasia. Andrew continues to require intense physical, occupational and speech therapies. Please help us, help Andrew and his family.
